



Patrick Torrington's aunt Thelma was a successful artist whose late work turned towards the occult. While staying with her in his teens he found evidence that she used to visit magical sites. As an adult he discovers her journal of her explorations, and his teenage son Roy becomes fascinated too. His experiences at the sites scare Patrick away from them, but Roy carries on the search, together with his new girlfriend. Can Patrick convince his son that his increasingly terrible suspicions are real, or will what they've helped to rouse take a new hold on the world?

Ramsey Campbell has been given more awards than any other writer in the field, including the Grand Master Award of the World Horror Convention, the Lifetime Achievement Award of the Horror Writers Association, the Living Legend Award of the International Horror Guild and the World Fantasy Lifetime Achievement Award. His novels *The Nameless* and *Pact of the Fathers* have been filmed in Spain and *The Influence* (re-published by FLAME TREE PRESS) is now a major movie on Netflix.

He is the President of the Society of Fantastic Films. *The Oxford Companion to English Literature* describes him as 'Britain's most respected living horror writer'. Ramsey Campbell was born in Liverpool in 1946 and still lives on Merseyside but travels and is respected throughout the world.





The book will gather stories from the mid-1950s until the twenty-first century by great names of the past, great names of the present together with a few hidden treasures by less familiar writers. The first CWA anthology, Butcher's Dozen, appeared in 1956, and was co-edited by Julian Symons, Michael Gilbert and Josephine Bell. The anthology has been edited by Martin Edwards since 1996, and has yielded many award-winning and nominated stories in the UK and overseas.

This new edition includes an array of incredible and award-winning authors: Robert Barnard, Simon Brett, Liza Cody, Mat Coward, John Dickson Carr, Marjorie Eccles, Martin Edwards, Kate Ellis, Anthea Fraser, Celia Fremlin, Frances Fyfield, Michael Gilbert, Paula Gosling, Lesley Grant-Adamson, HRF Keating, Bill Knox, Peter Lovesey, Mick Herron, Michael Z. Martin Edwards (Editor) is the author of eighteen novels, including the Harry Devlin series. His groundbreaking genre study The Golden Age of Murder has won the Edgar, Agatha, and H.R.F. Keating awards. He has edited twenty-eight crime anthologies, has won the CWA Short Story Dagger and the CWA Margery Allingham Prize. In 2015, he was elected eighth President of the Detection Club, an office previously held by G.K. Chesterton, Agatha Christie and Dorothy L. Sayers.

The CWA (Crime Writers' Association) was founded in 1953 by John Creasey, and organises the prestigious CWA Dagger Awards which celebrate the best in crime writing. The CWA is a pro-active, thriving and ever-expanding community of writers based in the UK but with a reach that extends worldwide.



Oscar leads a rescue party and our heroes are pursued by an unstoppable vampire bounty hunter who rides a dead, reanimated horse.

stories and novels; and practising photography.


Melissa Prusi was born and raised in the Upper Peninsula of Michigan, often mistaken for Canada. She's been a video editor, a semi-professional film



She attained a Bachelor's in Journalism, followed by an MBA, from the University of Missouri and currently works for the Department of Veterans Affairs by supporting new projects to improve the agency's healthcare systems. While working for the VA, she began her first novel, The Sentient. She has also written several short stories, including 'Exhibit K', which recently featured in Abyss and Apex magazine.
