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

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

Did you base your characters on anyone you knew?


There is a lot of me in Belinda and the Aztec Queen. I am filled with a deep sadness and rage. Both have guided both my good and bad decisions in life.

Who influenced you most in the writing of the book?

My family history. My great grandparents were farm workers. I also am influenced by my heritage. As a Mexican American woman, we are often left to stereotypes or ignored. I want to change that.

Is there any advice you can give someone starting to write?

I want to specifically speak to people of color and women of color. Your voice matters even when it feels like you are screaming in the wind. Don't hold back on your narrative because you feel it isn't 'enough' of one thing. Write for yourself and give yourself the freedom to express what lives inside of you. Yes, we are not represented as much as we should be but if you give up things will never change. Be bold and persevere.



Somebody's Voice. Ramsey Campbell

Alex Grand is a successful crime novelist until his latest book is condemned for appropriating the experience of victims of abuse. In a bid to rescue his reputation he ghostwrites a memoir of abuse on behalf of a survivor, Carl Batchelor. Carl's account proves to be less than entirely reliable; someone is alive who shouldn't be.

As Alex investigates the background of Carl's accusations his grasp of the truth of the book, and of his own involvement, begin to crumble. When he has to testify in a court case brought about by Carl's memoir, this may be one step too far for his insecure mind...

About the Author

Ramsey Campbell was born in Liverpool in 1946 and still lives on Merseyside. *The Oxford Companion to English Literature* describes him as 'Britain's most respected living horror writer'. He has been given more awards than any other writer in the field, including the Grand Master Award of the World Horror Convention, the Lifetime Achievement Award of the Horror Writers Association, the Living Legend Award of the International Horror Guild and the World Fantasy Lifetime Achievement Award.

In 2015 he was made an Honorary Fellow of Liverpool John Moores University for outstanding services to literature. 
About the Author



About the Author




Orwell is most well-known for his two famous books Nineteen Eighty-Four and Animal Farm, but their dystopian vision was informed by observations of poverty and disillusion with political events. George Orwell, the pseudonym of Eric Arthur Blair, was born in Bengal, India, in 1903. He was educated at Eton, became a policeman in Burma but suffered and studied poverty. His great works are a product of his hatred of totalitarianism. His legacy of writing and political thought is much admired today.

Richard Bradford (Introduction, and Editor) is Research Professor at Ulster University and Visiting Professor at Avignon University. He has held posts at Oxford, the University of Wales and Trinity College, Dublin, and has published thirty-five books.
