Patrick Torrington's aunt Thelma was a successful artist whose late work
turned towards the occult. While staying with her in his teens he found
evidence that she used to visit magical sites. As an adult he discovers her
journal of her explorations, and his teenage son Roy becomes fascinated

Roy carries on the search, together with his new girlfriend. Can Patrick

Ramsey Campbell has been given more awards than any other writer

Nameless* and *Pact of the Fathers* have been filmed in Spain and *The
Influence* (re-published by FLAME TREE PRESS) is now a major movie

He is the President of the Society of Fantastic Films. *The Oxford
Companion to English Literature* describes him as 'Britain's most
respected living horror writer'. Ramsey Campbell was born in Liverpool

Dr Bell also acts as editor for the Dickens Letters Project, and has a new biography of Dickens forthcoming.



The iconic **Charles Dickens** was born in 1812 in Portsmouth, though he spent much of his life in Kent and London. A prolific writer, Dickens kept up a career in journalism as well as writing short stories and novels, with much of his work being serialized before being published as books. He gave a view of contemporary England with a strong sense of realism, yet instilled his stories with a sense of charm, fantastic characters and humour like no other. He continued to work himself hard, until his death in 1870, leaving 'The Mystery of Edwin Drood' unfinished.

Isaac Newton
New Introduction by Kirill Krasnov
MATHEMATICAL PRINCIPLES OF NATURAL PHILOSOPHY

Mathematical Principles of Natural Philosophy, often known as the *Principia*, is one of the most important scientific works ever to have been written and has had a profound impact on modern science. Consisting of three separate books, the *Principia* state Newton's laws of motion and Newton's law of universal gravitation. Understanding and acceptance of these theories was not immediate, however by the end of the seventeenth century no one could deny that Newton had far exceeded all previous works and revolutionized scientific thinking.

Sir Isaac Newton (1642–1727) was an English physicist and mathematician who was a leading figure in the scientific revolution. His work throughout the seventeenth century provided the basis for modern science, including his three laws of motion and the law of universal gravitation. Newton's career was prolific. He was president of the Royal Society and in 1705 he was knighted, becoming the first ever scientist to receive the honour.

Kirill Krasnov is a Professor of Mathematical Physics at the University of Nottingham. He received a BSc in Physics from Kiev T. Shevchenko University in 1994 and a PhD in Physics from Pennsylvania State University in 1999. He has held Postdoctoral positions at the University of California, Santa Barbara and Max Planck Institute for Gravitational Physics, Potsdam. He has been the recipient of the prestigious EPSRC Advanced Fellowship and the ERC Consolidator Grant. Krasnov is most known for his work on black hole entropy within the loop approach to quantum gravity, work on spin foam models of quantum gravity, as well as work on the renormalized volume of hyperbolic 3-manifolds.

James Legge (translator)
New Introduction by Dennis Schilling
I CHING, OR THE BOOK OF CHANGES

Also known as *Y Ching*, *Yi jing* or the *Book of Changes*, *I Ching* is an ancient Chinese text of vast historical and cultural influence. Spanning the fields of divination, cosmology, morality and philosophy, with strong links to Confucianism, it has been interpreted in many different ways over the centuries and ultimately demonstrates an early attempt to understand the world and the human place within it.

Reviving James Legge's classic nineteenth-century translation, this latest title in a series of Great Works includes an illuminating new introduction that casts fresh light on this fascinating text.

Dennis Schilling is the Professor for Chinese Philosophy at the School of Philosophy, Renmin University of China. He studied Sinology, Philosophy and Japanology at the universities of Würzburg, Munich, Wuhan/PR China, and received his doctorate and habilitation at the University of Munich. His doctoral thesis explores metaphysical, political and ethical ideas in Chinese divination texts imitating the composition and style of the ancient manual *Yi jing*. Currently, his research focuses on ideas of life and death in ancient and medieval China and on the metaphysics of time and change in Chinese philosophy. He is also engaged in comparative philosophy and teaches Chinese Metaphysics, Daoist philosophy and *Yi jing* studies.

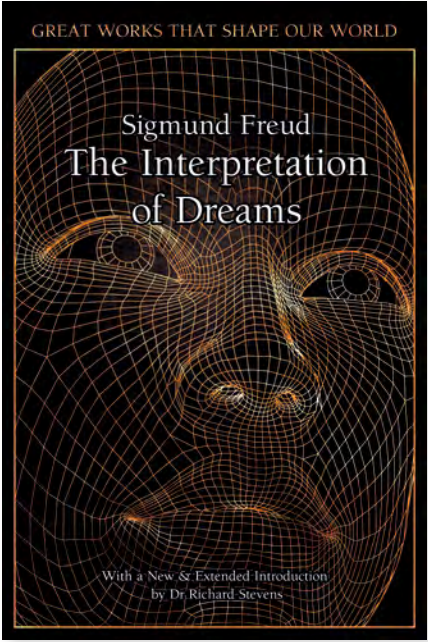

THE INTERPRETATION OF DREAMS

The seminal work of psychological and cultural heritage and probably the most important of Freud's impressive output. Published in 1899 but revised by Freud himself many times, it outlines his theories on the unconscious and dream symbolism. The famously influential neurologist and founder of psychoanalysis, **Sigmund Freud** (1856–1939) was born in a small town in what is now the Czech Republic. He worked in a practical capacity in a hospital and conducted cerebral anatomy research, but in 1886 set up in private clinical practice in treating 'nervous disorders' and would go on to develop the various techniques associated with psychoanalysis, as well as his famous theories on the unconscious, the human psyche, dreams and sexuality – leading to the publication of many works, including *Beyond the Pleasure Principle* (1920) and *The Ego and the Id* (1923).

Previously Head of Psychology at the Open University, **Richard Stevens** holds a first-class degree in Psychology from the University of Edinburgh as well as an MA (Trinity College Dublin) and a PhD by published work. He has been Chair of the Association for Humanistic Psychology in Britain and helped to found the Consciousness and Experiential Section of the British Psychological Society. His books include *Freud and Psychoanalysis* and *Understanding the Self* and he has numerous publications in academic and other journals.

New Introduction by Dr Andrew Wilson
THE ART OF WAR

The Art of War has been a source of great strategical inspiration throughout the ages. Focusing on military strategy, psychology and tactics, each section concentrates on a different facet of warfare and draws out important themes such as communication, strength and positioning. Believed to have been written by Chinese strategist Sun Tzu, *The Art of War* is highly regarded amongst Chinese culture, but its enduring wisdom has had a far-reaching impact all over the world. This edition is based on the translation by Lionel Giles.

Little is known with certainty about **Sun Tzu**. His given name was actually Sun Wu; 'Tzu' is a title meaning 'Master'. It is believed that he was born in the ancient Chinese state of Ch'i (Qi), located in modern Shandong, a province bordering the Yellow Sea on China's east coast. Traditional accounts record that he served Ho Lu (Helu), the king of Wu, during the late Spring and Autumn Period of the Chou (Zhou) Dynasty (722–481 bc), while others dispute this, claiming he was a professional general during the Warring States era (475–221 bc). His treatise became one of the Seven Military Classics, a collection of texts on the art of war that were required reading for imperial officers throughout Chinese history (*The Sayings of Wu* by Wu Ch'i, also included in our edition, is another of these texts).

Andrew R. Wilson is a professor of Strategy & Policy at the U.S. Naval War College, where he teaches a mix of strategic theory and military history to help hone the critical analysis skills of military officers. In particular, he looks at how the classics of Chinese military thought, including Sun Tzu, have influenced Chinese strategic behaviour from the early Imperial period to the present. He received a PhD in History and East Asian Languages from Harvard University and taught Chinese history at Harvard and at Wellesley College prior to joining the Naval War College faculty in 1998, where he currently holds the John A. van Beuren Chair of Asia-Pacific Studies.

JIMI HENDRIX: FROM WOODSTOCK, WITH LOVE...

Seattle-born guitarist, songwriter and singer Jimi Hendrix soared to the very top rank of all guitarists quickly after arriving in London at the height of the British Blues boom. Jeff Beck and Jimmy Page stood back in amazement while Eric Clapton, a god of the guitar at the time, was destroyed by the brilliance of this quixotic presence and never recovered. Later, Hendrix, riding his success back to the US, saw his energy and experimentation bring accolades from industry and audiences alike. At Woodstock his rendition of *The Star-Spangled Banner* was a defiant burst of electric glamour that reached back to the field holler of the blues, and forward to the roots of modern rock. His drug-related death in September 1970 was a shock, but the influence of Jimi Hendrix burns ever brighter, his reputation growing with each new generation.

This new illustrated book is a timely introduction for the 50th anniversary of Hendrix's death in September 1970. It covers his early years as a jobbing musician, recordings, live performances and offers a gallery of striking images.

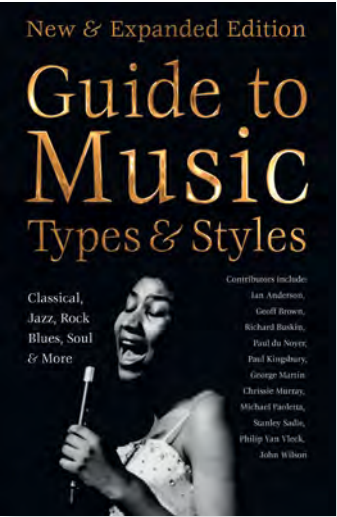

JANIS JOPLIN: THE QUEEN OF PSYCHEDELIC SOUL



Influenced by Bessie Smith, Janis Joplin became a rock star in San Francisco's Big Brother & The Holding Company, and enjoyed a meteoric solo career before her untimely death from a drug overdose in Los Angeles. She was the most compelling female blues singer of the 1960s with a thrilling, emotional depth and a fiery stage presence that dominated albums such as Big Brother's *Cheap Thrills* (1968) and the posthumous, chart-topping *Pearl* (1971). She became the voice of a generation with her weary, cynical tone, one that still resonates with the curious and wistful youth of today who are faced with a music scene saturated by rap.

Janis Joplin sadly passed away in time to join the infamous 27 club of artists and musicians who died in their 27th year. She joined, amongst others, Robert Johnson, Jim Morrison and Brian Jones. The 50th anniversary of Joplin's death is in October 2020. This new book in the Flame Tree Rock Icons series covers her life, recordings and live performances, accompanied by a wide range of posters and photos.

Stanley Sadie (contributing editor and author) was music critic for *The Times* for 17 years, editor of *The Musical Times* for 20 years and music consultant to the television series *Man and Music*, and from 1970 worked as Editor of the standard reference work, *The New Grove Dictionary of Music and Musicians* (1980, new edition 2000) as well as its associated dictionaries, on instruments, opera and American music. He wrote extensively on Mozart and Handel and was president of the Royal Musical Association (1989–94) and the International Musicological Society (1992–97). He was appointed CBE in 1982.

Its roots spread wide and deep, and much social and intellectual revitalization had begun before this revered time, but the renewed interest in ancient Greek and Roman texts and the development of expanding trade, which brought greater wealth, meant that classical and humanist thought combined with lavish patronage resulted in major breakthroughs across all spheres of human endeavour – art, architecture, music, literature, science, philosophy and more. And, while it spread across Europe, it was Italy that was to be its crucible.

With 2020 marking the 500th anniversary of the death of Raphael, one of the stars of the Renaissance, this sumptuous book celebrates the prolific output of this era. From the radical perspective of Giotto di Bondone (1267–1337), breaking out of the Middle Ages, to the giants of the High Renaissance: Leonardo da Vinci, Michelangelo and Raphael, and many more, the reader will delight in the fascinating insights offered by the text accompanied by lush reproductions.

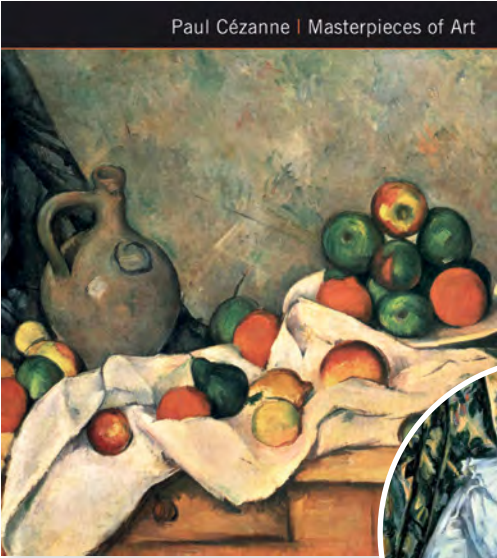

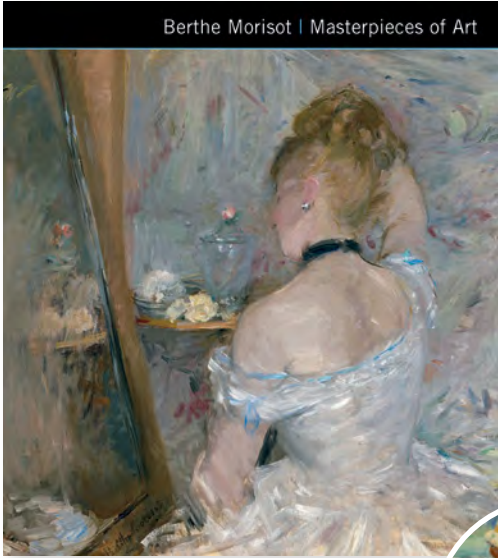

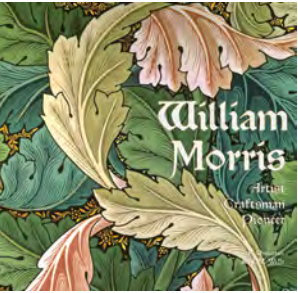

BERTHE MORISOT
